- Is original and not previously published elsewhere.
- Is evidence-based, accurate, and appropriately referenced where necessary (through hyperlinks, footnotes, or endnotes).
- Presents a clear argument or perspective supported by credible sources.

- Is written in an accessible style for a broad policy audience.
- Is typically between **800–2,000 words** (longer essays may be considered where appropriate).

Submission does not guarantee publication, and we reserve the right to decline articles that do not align with our editorial standards or thematic focus.
